Bean Bag Toss

Have your child toss bean bags into a box with wrapping paper on it. You can use masking tape to mark where the child should stand.

Tree Sizina

Cut out many different sized trees. Ask the children to line up the trees from largest to smallest.

Star Sizing:

Cut out many different sized stars. Ask the children to line up the stars from largest to smallest.



Cookie Cutter Tree Prints

Put a small amount of tempera paint in a large shallow container. (A pie tin works well) Show your child how to dip a Christmas Tree cookie cutter in the paint and press onto a piece of paper to create a print. You can make holiday pictures or greeting cards by using holiday cookie cutters and colored paper. also learn how other countries and cultures around the world celebrate the holiday season while having so



Reindeer Chow

9 cups Rice Chex, Corn Chex, or Chocolate Chex

- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- ½ cup peanut butter
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1½ cup powdered sugar

1 cup holiday M&M's (any variety)

- 1. Measure cereal and pour into large bowl; set aside.
- 2. In 1-quart microwavable bowl, microwave chocolate chips, peanut butter and butter un-covered on high for 1 minute; stir. Microwave about 30 seconds longer or until mixture can be stirred smooth. Stir in vanilla.
- Pour mixture over cereal, stir-ring until evenly coated. Pour into 2-gallon | glue onto the paper towel roll. resealable plastic bag.
- 4. Add powdered sugar. Seal bag; shake until well coated. Spread on waxed paper to cool.

Add M&M's and stir into mixture. Store in airtight container

Count the Stripes

Make many different candy cane shapes with different numbers of stripes. Have the children count the stripes on the candy canes. If you made candy cane art (above) then have each child count the stripes on their candy cane. You could ask the children who had the most, the least and make a chart of how many lines were on the candy canes. Which number of stripes did most people make?

Paper Plate Christmas Tree

Cut 2 paper plates into 3 triangular pieces and paint green. Paint a paper towel roll brown. Cut slits in it about 1/3 of the way up on one end. Spread and tape to another paper plate. Glue tree pieces together and decorate with button, gems, sequins or paper dots. Add a star at the top and



Stunning Christmas Stocking

- 1. Cut a sock shape out of two pieces of felt.
- 2. Staple the edges together a half inch from the sides, leaving the top open.
- 3. Glue rickrack over the staples to cover them.

Add a felt loop to the top corner of the stocking for hanging. Decorate with felt and buttons.
